Floodplain Management Specialist

Duties:

- Coordinate with immediate supervisor to identify State and local Hazard Mitigation priorities
- Communicate Hazard Mitigation program information and provide recommendations to communities to advance floodplain management concepts
- Communicate with internal partners (e.g., Individual Assistance, Public Assistance and Small Business Administration)
- Work with local officials, such as city/county councils, building officials, and floodplain managers in coordination with the State
- Provide basic technical assistance to internal and external partners on floodplain management
- Analyze program-related data to make recommendations and identify problems
- Demonstrate capability to use applicable systems, tools, and equipment

Qualifications:

- Experience in the application of floodplain management theories and practices; OR
- Experience with floodplain permits to include land use of permit processing and substantive review sequencing; or
- Experience working with Floodplain Management with a directly related Federal Agency; OR
- Private or non-profit experience with Watershed Commissions, Conservation Groups, or similar entities that focus on substantial waterway or flood plain related causes; OR
- Experience as a local Floodplain Management Specialist working through the certification process or a local Floodplain Management Specialist working through the re-certification process in addition to experience that indicates knowledge of insurance program compliance.
