Duties

The Environmental Specialist provides support for the Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation (EHP) Cadre review, reports, and compliance at JFOs during incident management responses. Primary duties include the following:

- Reviews a wide range of environmental, scientific, technical, management, engineering, socio-economic, and legal issues for all FEMA's programs.
- Makes recommendations to the JFO EHP Manager on environmental and historic preservation policy and procedures, and program guidance and training information on environmental/historic preservation compliance issues.
- Serves as project or technical monitor for FEMA task orders and Interagency Agreements addressing environmental/historic preservation compliance issues.
- Preparation and/or review of studies, written reports, charts, graphs, maps, and other documentation that describes the technical methods and results of surveys of properties identified for environmental impact statements, environmental assessments, survey reports, and design memoranda. The preparation of documentation may concern items of archaeological, geological, and historical significance in relation to other environmental factors that are considered in selecting and recommending the most desirable plan of development.

Experienced Desired:

- Bachelor's degree in related environmental field from an accredited university a plus
- Professional experience in field of study
- Knowledge and/or experience with the Federal laws and statues a Plus such as NEPA, the Clean Water Act, Clean Air Act, Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act, Endangered Species Act, Coastal Barrier Resources Act, Coastal Zone Management Act, E.O. 11593 Cultural Environmental; National Historic Preservation Act, Archaeological and Historic Preservation Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, and E.O. 12898 Environmental Justice.
- Knowledge of statues, regulations, licensing/permitting requirements for planning, implementing, or monitoring environmental programs and services a plus.
 - Although not required, experience using Environmental Historic Preservation (EHP) related computer applications is highly desired
