

Floodplain Specialist

DUTIES:

The Environmental Floodplain Specialist provides subject matter expertise in environmental floodplain considerations for Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation

(EHP) review, reports, and compliance. Primary duties include the following:

- Collect data to support compliance with 44 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 9—Floodplain Management;
- Identify Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation (EHP) resource considerations in a Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA);
- Gather information for disaster-specific guidance;
- Obtain existing resources that can be used to facilitate flood plain reviews;
- Synthesize information using EHP-related computer applications;
- Manage documentation according to the EHP Management Plan;
- Provide technical assistance on floodplain considerations to the incident management organization and external stakeholders; and Prepare and submit written EHP reports and other documents through proper channels.

- Experience with Floodplain Management laws, executive orders, regulations, agreements, policies and procedures a must.
- Bachelor's degree in related field a plus
- Certified **floodplain** manager not required but a plus
